Investing in training

We invest over £2m a year in training to ensure that our people are equipped with the skills needed for a modern construction industry. Our industry needs to attract new people, so it was exciting to see the Essex Employment and Skills Board (EESB) achieve two successful bids for on-site training hubs as part of the Construction Skills Fund.

As part of the community, we will be engaging with training providers on the skills that we need so we can support the EESB's work to upskill a generation of young people, enabling them to enjoy long-term jobs in construction and engineering.

An education leader

We also want to help shape Essex as a destination for learning. Following our work at Passmores Academy and Harlow College's new Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering Centre, we recently completed Essex's first medical school, at Anglia Ruskin University, and also Stansted Airport College, which makes Essex an aviation leader.

Shaping Essex's future From groundbreaking aviation and medical schools to exemplar housing, our projects are transforming the county's communities



Stansted Airport College Cementing Essex's role at the heart of the aviation industry, the college is the first of its kind at any airport in the country. It offers learning in disciplines such as aviation, engineering and business.



Colchester Institute

We helped make Colchester Institute fit for the 21st-century learning agenda at the Sheepen Road Campus. Our work on phase one provided flexible spaces to accommodate a steady growth in student numbers.



Passmores Academy, Harlow We gave the academy a new home at the former Brays Grove School, providing a facility to accommodate 1,200 11-16 year olds. This included retaining the 'spirit of Passmores' on the new site.



Sapphire Ice Rink and Pool, Romford This flagship complex is home to top ice hockey team the London Raiders. The 900seat ice rink arena sits on top of a suite of modern leisure facilities, including an eightlane swimming pool and fitness centre.



Bruyns Court, Thurrock

We built 25 apartments for the over-55s on a former car park, arranged in three buildings and linked by glass walkways. The three and four-storey homes were part of nearly 200 we built recently for Thurrock Council.



St Chad's, Tilbury St Chad's is a development of 128 homes by Bell Phillips Architects that supports Thurrock Council's aims of regenerating the town with new, subsidised housing.





Harlow College The new Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering Centre is equipped with machinery from around the world. It provides a link between students and industry, equipping local people with in-demand skills.



School of Medicine, Anglia Ruskin University, Chelmsford


Essex's first medical school has world-class facilities including simulation rooms and an anatomy suite. The aim is that 50 percent of students will be from the East of England.
