Directions to the office

From the M6 by car

- Leave M6 at junction 6 and join A38(M) signposted Birmingham Central
- Stay in the lane signposted Birmingham City Centre
- After approximately half a mile the A38(M) ends. Stay on A38 to flyover (A41)
- Exit flyover and move into left hand lane Snow Hill/A38
- Turn next left onto Whittall Street
- Turn next right onto Weaman Street
- Follow the road around to the left; B4 car park is on your left
- Exit the car park via pedestrian exit onto Weaman Street, turn left
- Cross over the road and walk past the front of Lloyd House, West Midlands Police HQ
- One Snowhill is the large glass building across the road

From the M5 by car

- Leave M5 at Junction 3 and join the Quinton Expressway to Five Ways Island, Edgbaston
- Turn right onto A4540 then left onto Bath Row (B4127)
- At the roundabout, take the first exit onto Suffolk Street Queensway
- Get into right hand lane and take the slip road onto A38
- Continue on A38 to Snow Hill Queensway then merge onto Suffolk Street Queensway
- Use the 2nd from left lane to turn slightly left onto Great Charles Street Queensway (A4400)
- Turn right onto Snow Hill Queensway
- At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto Weaman Street
- B4 car park entrance is on the right
- Follow pedestrian instructions as per M6

By train

- The nearest main line station is New Street and the nearest local station is Snow Hill
- On foot from the station: New Street Station is about 10 mins walk to the office. Through the ticket barrier and turn right out of the station onto Stephenson Street. Follow the road round to the right and up Corporation Street
- Turn left at House of Fraser and walk up Cherry Street before bearing right and cutting straight across St.Philips Place. The Barclays branch will be visible on the corner of Colmore Row next to Snow Hill Station. Walk towards Snow Hill Station entrance. One Snowhill is the new glass building at the bottom of the steps
