95% of our people understand why sustainability is a business priority

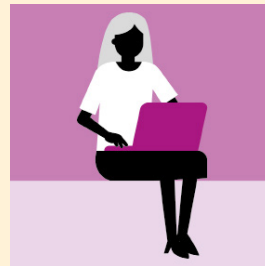
Collaborated with the **Supply Chain Sustainability School** to develop a carbon calculator tool for the industry's shared supply chain
